# **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE**

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### **INSTRUCTION**

#### **Co-Curricular Program/Activities**

- A. The district recognizes that co-curricular programs and activities are an integral part of the educational structure. Participation in these programs is voluntary, and the individual has freedom of choice in selecting activities within the limitations of program offerings. The co-curricular program is governed and approved through the Associated Student Body of each school. Co-curricular programs include athletics, music, forensics, drama, publications and other clubs and activities assigned an advisor.
- B. The building principal is delegated primary responsibility to provide administrative support, qualified personnel, facilities and financial structure to operate the program. (See procedures as outlined in 3510 P). The welfare of the participants shall be of primary concern. The activities programs are under the same administration and control as the rest of the school program. Student participation is governed by rules, which are an extension of the regular school day.
- C. The coaches and advisors of the co-curricular program must assume a major role in the leadership of the youth in their charge. They should teach and develop fundamental skills, set meaningful goals, develop roles for participants, foster leadership, cooperation, self-discipline, sportsmanship, ethical behavior and good citizenship. Successful performance, including winning, should occur as an outgrowth of ethical leadership, coaching and competition.
- D. Qualifications and responsibilities for a coaching position are described in Addendum A-10 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Northshore School District and Northshore Education Association in the “ Perspectives on Coaching Positions.”
- E. The interscholastic athletics and activities program shall be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Washington Interscholastic Activities Association, the Northshore School District, KINGCO League and other groups of which schools, clubs or activities are members.

- F. The district will comply with RCW 28A.640 concerning the prevention of sex discrimination by conducting a survey once every three years to assess the needs and desires of both boys' and girls' co-curricular programs.

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- G. The district will comply with RCW 28A.640 and WAC 392-190-030 by evaluating equity criteria. A self-evaluation survey will evaluate progress in meeting equity standards. The self-study shall consider:
